Dear Franklin Parents/Guardians,

We value your input and support as we partner in the education of our students. We are writing to inform you of changes made regarding mid-marking period progress reporting.

As you may be aware, for the 2016-2017 school year, in an effort to increase parent communication and feedback, Stratford Public schools has changed from a three marking period to a four marking period system. This has eliminated the need to provide mid-marking period progress reports for all students.

However, if there is a significant change noted in a student's progress from your child's last report card, parents/guardians will receive a mid-marking period progress report noting the change in that particular content area. If you do not receive a progress report, that means that your child is continuing to make progress as noted on their report card and during student conferences.

Please note that you as parents and guardians are at liberty to view your child's progress at any point in the school year. Parents of students in grades K-3 should call or email the classroom teacher for an updated summary of the student's performance. Parents of students in grades 4-6 may utilize the Parent Portal to view your child's grades. Please contact the office if you don't have your Parent Portal username and password.
